1. The Basics:

- Add Section
- 2. Enter lyrics. Put each phrase on a new line.
- 3. Place chords within brackets before the word or syllable they land on. (See Example)

2. Example:

[Bm] You call me out [A/C#]upon the[D] waters

The great un[A]known where feet may[G] fail

[Bm] And there I find You [A/C#]in the [D]mystery

In oceans[A] deep my faith wil[G]I stand

3. Get your chord in the exact spot it needs to be:

Standard Chord:

Cmaj7

You are [Cmaj7]great → You are great

Trailing Chord:

Cmaj7

You are great [Cmaj7] → You are great

Space Chord:

Cmaj7

You are [Cmaj7] great → You are great

Split-Lyric Chord:

Cmaj7

You are ma[Cmaj7]jestic → You are majestic
