

1. The Basics:

1. Add Section
2. Enter lyrics. Put each phrase on a new line.
3. Place chords within brackets before the word or syllable they land on. (See Example)

2. Example:

[Bm] You call me out [A/C#] upon the [D] waters
 The great un[A]known where feet may [G] fail
 [Bm] And there I find You [A/C#] in the [D] mystery
 In oceans [A] deep my faith wil [G] I stand

3. Get your chord in the exact spot it needs to be:

Standard Chord:

You are [Cmaj7] great → You are Cmaj7 great

Trailing Chord:

You are great [Cmaj7] → You are great Cmaj7

Space Chord:

You are [Cmaj7] great → You are Cmaj7 great

Split-Lyric Chord:

You are ma[Cmaj7]jestic → You are majestic Cmaj7
